WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT DNOW...

- DNOW stands for Disciple Now.
- Disciple Now is a Youth Ministry Outreach of the Loudon County Baptist Association for our Loudon County churches.
- The cost is \$45 per student and \$10 per adult leader. 100% of the admission is used to cover event costs for the Guest Speaker, Band, Meal, T-Shirts and event expenses.
- DNOW outreach is for Middle, High School and College age students.
- Students stay overnight in Host Homes provided by their home church members. Host homes are split with boys at one home and girls at another. Depending on the size of the youth group host homes may be split by middle and high school age students as well.
- Host homes provide a place for students to sleep, eat and have small group time. Breakfast is typically provided by the host home each morning before devotion time. Devotion is done by one of the Youth Leaders. Students can use air mattresses and sleeping bags when needed at their host homes.
- Transportation to and from the church is provided by the individual church leaders. Vans are recommended to keep students together during travel time.
- The DNOW Youth Conference is hosted at a one of our Associational churches on Friday and Saturday.
- Friday evening dinner is provided by individual churches to their students prior to coming to the DNOW event.
- Youth Leaders will meet on Friday at 7:30pm prior to the start of the event to pray together and go over details and expectations for the weekend. The Guest Speaker and Band will meet and speak with the youth leaders.

- DNOW kickoff will begin in the sanctuary for a time of Worship with a Worship band. The Guest Speaker will lead in a time of scripture and teaching.
- An altar call will be done on the first night of DNOW. Youth Leaders will be directed to stand at designated areas to assist students that come to pray and seek guidance.
- Small Group times are held at the host homes at night after the evening sessions as a recap.
- A catered KFC boxed lunch is provided on Saturday.
- DNOW T-shirts will be provided by pre-order in advance. Churches will submit their sizes needed by the deadline. After the deadline, t-shirts will be on a first come first serve basis based on what sizes we have left available.
- Devotion booklets will be given to Youth Leaders prior to the event.
- Guest Speakers and the Band will have merchandise tables set up if students would like to purchase items.
- On Saturday, we will dismiss after lunch for Free Time. Each individual church will be in charge of free time and dinner for their students. Typically students eat dinner at the host homes.
- Students will report back to the church for the final session of DNOW at 7:00pm.
- On Sunday, Students will attend morning worship services back at their home church together while wearing their DNOW shirts.
